Highlights

- 99% of parents feel welcome in our school community.
- Parents (86.2%) and teachers (93.5%) shared an increase in Student Learning Engagement. This is higher than the provincial average.
- Students shared an increase (79.2%) in opportunities to model the characteristics of active citizenship.
- Students (84.6%), parents (87.4%) and teachers (87.5%) all shared an increase in our school community being a safe, caring, welcoming place for all students.

- Students will visit our chapel each month to participate in Bible Bytes—engaging mini-lessons rooted in scripture. These sessions will inspire students to live out God's word and align with our mission to serve and uplift the community.
- This year we are excited to recognize student achievement aligning with the Seven Sacred Teachings. Each month, our school community will focus on one of the Seven Sacred teachings. This will be brought to life in classroom activities and school messaging. At the end of each month, students will be recognized in front of their peers and family for portraying this important attribute.
- We are actively providing parents with authentic opportunities to become involved in their child's schooling. Parents are invited to all school liturgies and all masses at St. Stephen Parish. Other opportunities include Guest Readers at our Read-a-Thon and supporting classroom activities organized by teachers. All parent volunteer opportunities are communicated throughout social media and classroom newsletters.
